

It is important that all Answer Checkers **follow these steps carefully.**

MARKING QUESTIONS

Correct



Mark the star **each time** they get **all** parts of a question right. (1st, 2nd, or 3rd try)

Incorrect



Mark one pirate **each time** they **DO NOT** get **all** parts of a question right.

NEVER GIVE MORE THAN 1 CHIP/TOKEN AT A TIME!!!

GIVING CHIPS, TOKENS & NEW QUESTIONS



Give **1** yellow chip if they get **all** parts of the question right **on the 1st try.**



Give **1** wooden token if they get **all** parts of the question right on the 2nd or 3rd try.

Give a new question after they get **all** parts of the question right **OR** turn a question in because they feel it is too difficult.

What kind of help can you give? **NONE - EXCEPT - once** they have missed a question, it's **OK** to point out which parts were incorrect when you see this. →

DO NOT indicate **why** they were correct or incorrect.

NO HELP is given at all when you see this. →

OTHER IMPORTANT INFO

- Groups have 3 tries per question.
- Groups may turn in (pass on) questions at any time.

DO

- Place used questions **face down.**
- Hide answer keys from **wandering eyes.**
- Try to pick questions **randomly** & from the **correct group.**

DON'T Help the students.

- Note: **You MAY** encourage them and say things like, "Be sure to read the question carefully," or, "Sorry, Try again."

- Set turned-in questions aside & face down. (If a group runs out of questions, these may be given back one at a time. - This keeps students from being idle.)
